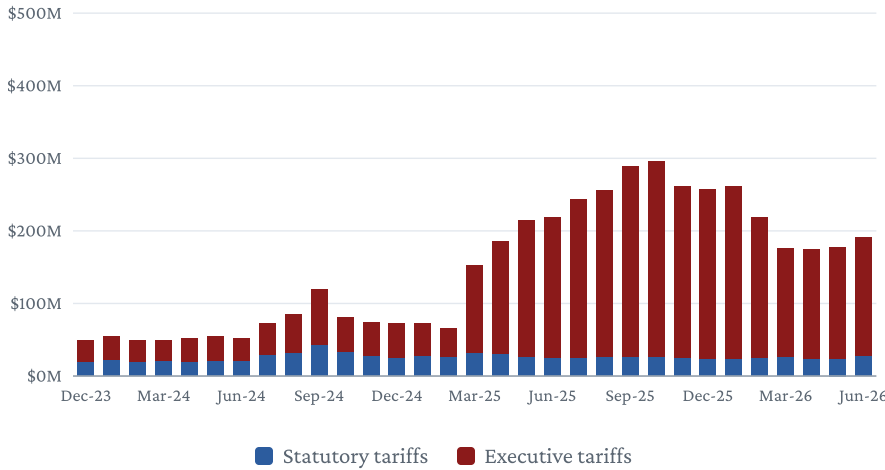

 Misc. electronic components	\$169M	12.1%	8× the 2024 rate of 1.5%

Methodology. Figures are estimates of tariffs paid on imports into Arizona, split between statutory tariffs and executive tariffs imposed by presidential action, of which \$3.2 billion has been imposed since January 2025.
