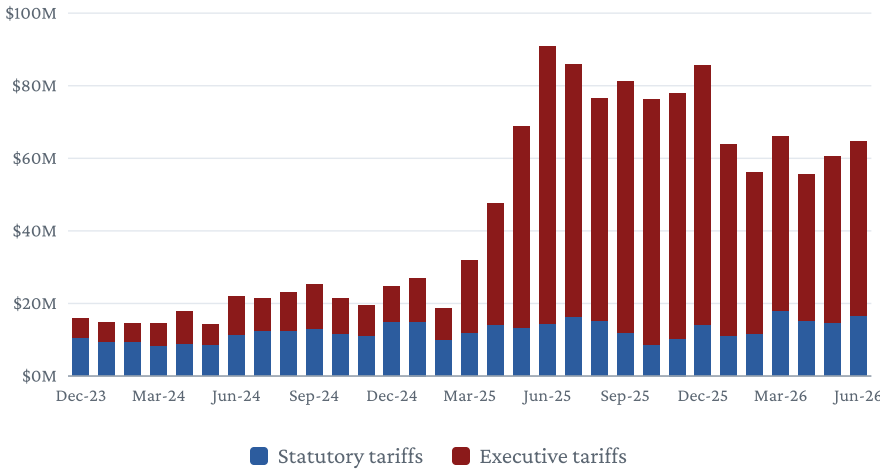

Key Delaware Imports Facing Executive Tariffs

Clothes & shoes	\$110M	32.2%	1.8× the 2024 rate of 18.4%
Food & beverages	\$103M	7.0%	2.5× the 2024 rate of 2.8%
Electrical equipment	\$71M	11.8%	4× the 2024 rate of 3.0%
Semiconductors & related devices	\$68M	20.4%	5.3× the 2024 rate of 3.8%

Methodology. Figures are estimates of tariffs paid on imports into Delaware, split between statutory tariffs and executive tariffs imposed by presidential action, of which \$893 million has been imposed since January 2025.
