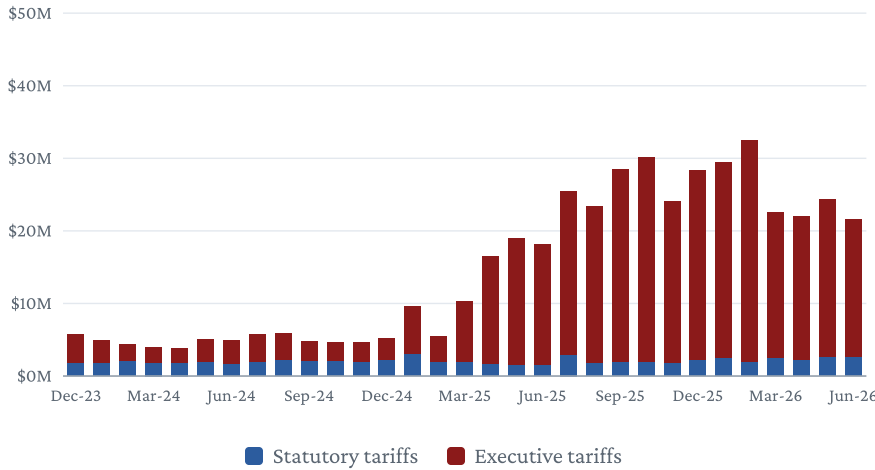

Key Idaho Imports Facing Executive Tariffs

 Electrical equipment	\$29M	16.4%	6.6× the 2024 rate of 2.5%
 Measuring & checking equipment	\$25M	13.1%	16× the 2024 rate of 0.8%
 Industrial machinery, parts & controls	\$21M	1.8%	5.9× the 2024 rate of 0.3%
 Machinery & parts	\$20M	12.3%	6.6× the 2024 rate of 1.9%

Methodology. Figures are estimates of tariffs paid on imports into Idaho, split between statutory tariffs and executive tariffs imposed by presidential action, of which \$352 million has been imposed since January 2025.
