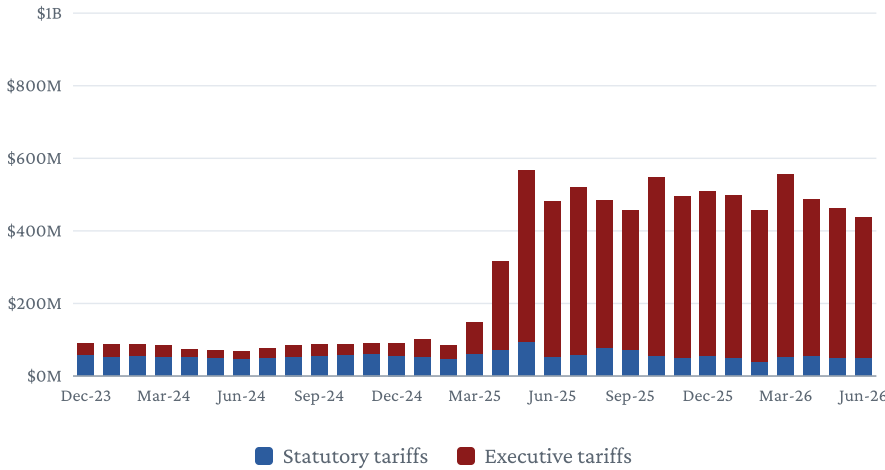

Key Maryland Imports Facing Executive Tariffs

Cars & trucks	\$2.1B	16.5%	8.3× the 2024 rate of 2.0%
Steel, aluminum & other metals	\$931M	13.5%	6.1× the 2024 rate of 2.2%
Ag & construction equipment	\$629M	22.0%	35× the 2024 rate of 0.6%
Food & beverages	\$470M	11.0%	7.6× the 2024 rate of 1.5%

Methodology. Figures are estimates of tariffs paid on imports into Maryland, split between statutory tariffs and executive tariffs imposed by presidential action, of which \$6.6 billion has been imposed since January 2025.
