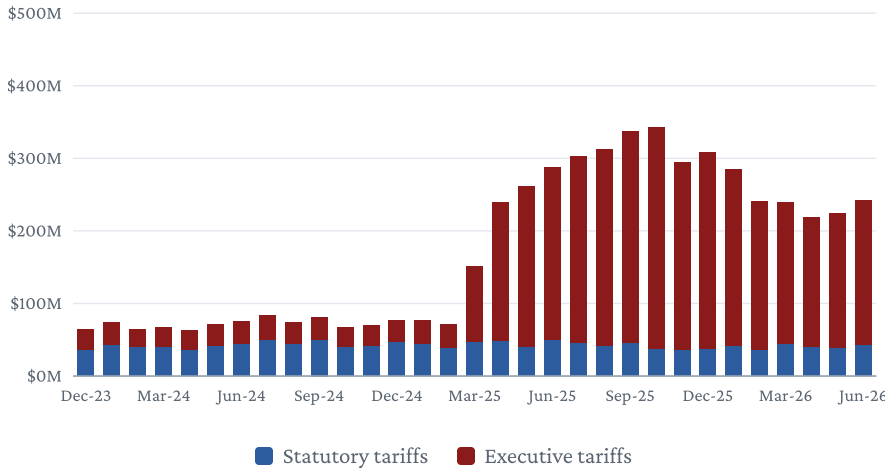

Methodology. Figures are estimates of tariffs paid on imports into Massachusetts, split between statutory tariffs and executive tariffs imposed by presidential action, of which \$3.7 billion has been imposed since January 2025.
