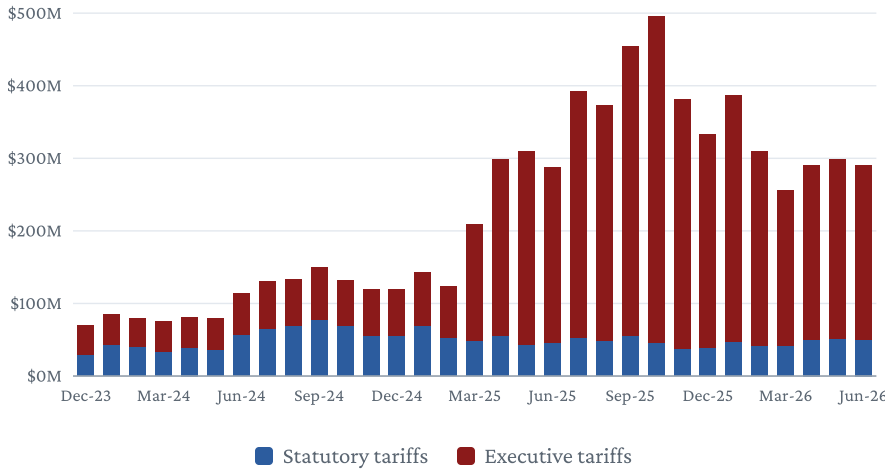

Key Minnesota Imports Facing Executive Tariffs

Toys & games	\$616M	19.9%	21× the 2024 rate of 1.0%
Clothes & shoes	\$419M	30.4%	1.9× the 2024 rate of 16.4%
Electrical equipment	\$305M	16.8%	2.8× the 2024 rate of 6.1%
Household goods	\$291M	27.9%	3.3× the 2024 rate of 8.4%

Methodology. Figures are estimates of tariffs paid on imports into Minnesota, split between statutory tariffs and executive tariffs imposed by presidential action, of which \$4.8 billion has been imposed since January 2025.
