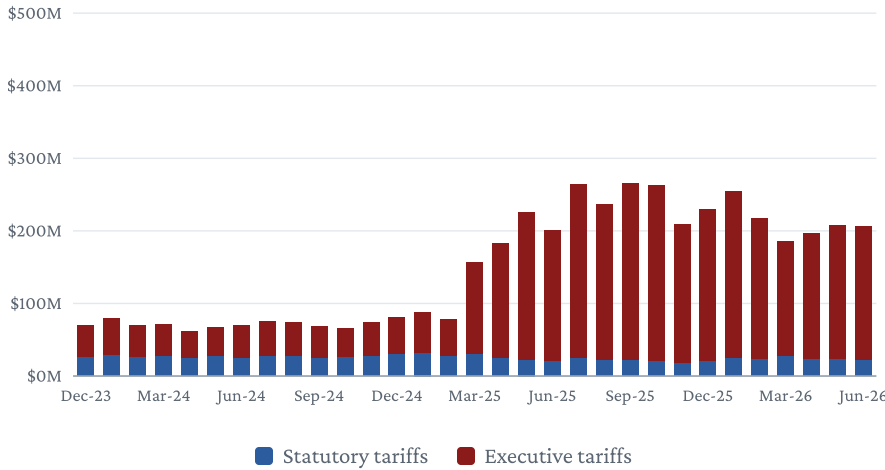

Key Missouri Imports Facing Executive Tariffs

Steel, aluminum & other metals	\$295M	29.3%	7.7× the 2024 rate of 3.8%
Auto parts	\$286M	13.7%	3× the 2024 rate of 4.5%
Metal products	\$249M	29.7%	5.4× the 2024 rate of 5.5%
Chemicals	\$197M	11.5%	2.1× the 2024 rate of 5.6%

Methodology. Figures are estimates of tariffs paid on imports into Missouri, split between statutory tariffs and executive tariffs imposed by presidential action, of which \$3.2 billion has been imposed since January 2025.
