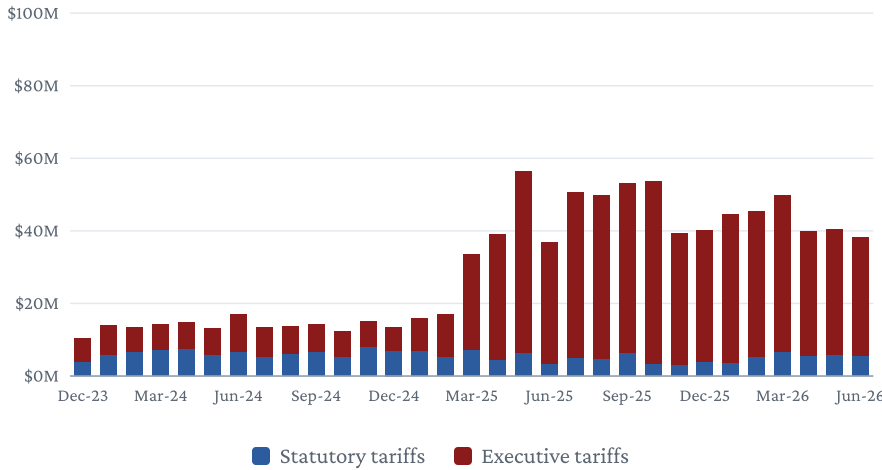

Key Nebraska Imports Facing Executive Tariffs

Auto parts	\$57M	19.8%	2.8× the 2024 rate of 7.1%
Ag & construction equipment	\$40M	15.3%	16× the 2024 rate of 0.9%
Chemicals	\$36M	8.2%	2.2× the 2024 rate of 3.8%
Railroad equipment	\$36M	27.6%	65× the 2024 rate of 0.4%

Methodology. Figures are estimates of tariffs paid on imports into Nebraska, split between statutory tariffs and executive tariffs imposed by presidential action, of which \$650 million has been imposed since January 2025.
