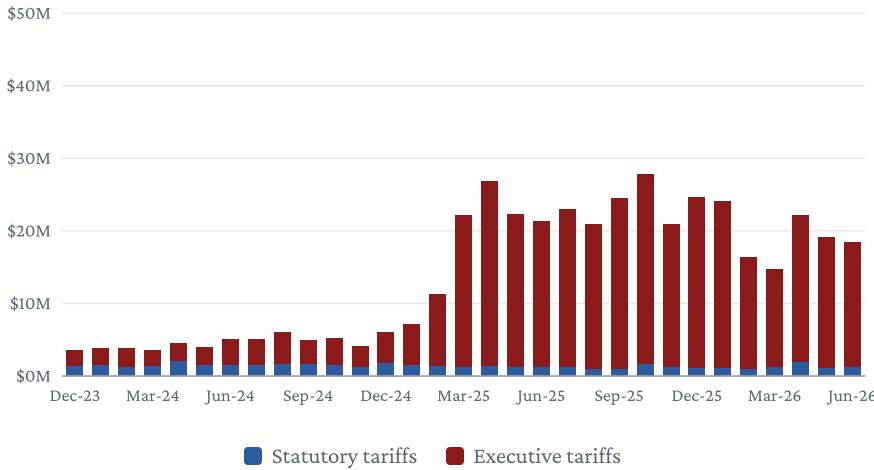

Methodology. Figures are estimates of tariffs paid on imports into New Mexico, split between statutory tariffs and executive tariffs imposed by presidential action, of which \$344 million has been imposed since January 2025.
