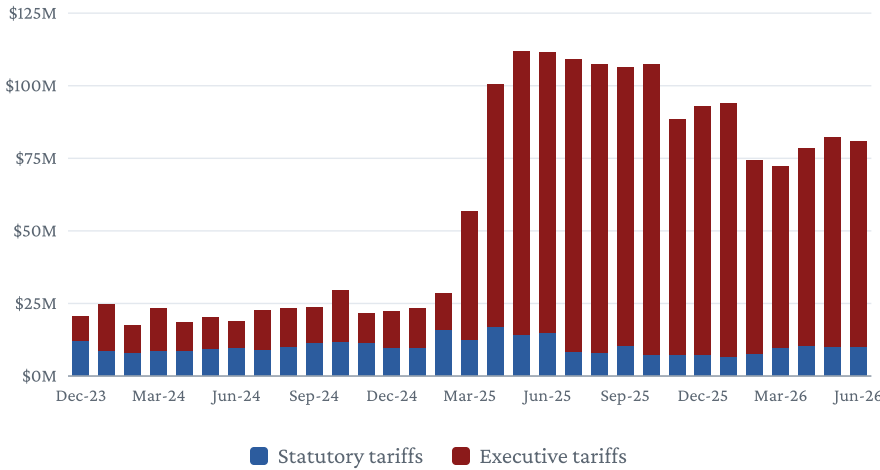

Key Puerto Rico Imports Facing Executive Tariffs

Cars & trucks	\$214M	16.5%	13× the 2024 rate of 1.3%
Food & beverages	\$178M	9.3%	3.9× the 2024 rate of 2.4%
Steel, aluminum & other metals	\$115M	41.1%	4.9× the 2024 rate of 8.4%
Electrical equipment	\$104M	20.2%	3.4× the 2024 rate of 5.9%

Methodology. Figures are estimates of tariffs paid on imports into Puerto Rico, split between statutory tariffs and executive tariffs imposed by presidential action, of which \$1.3 billion has been imposed since January 2025.
