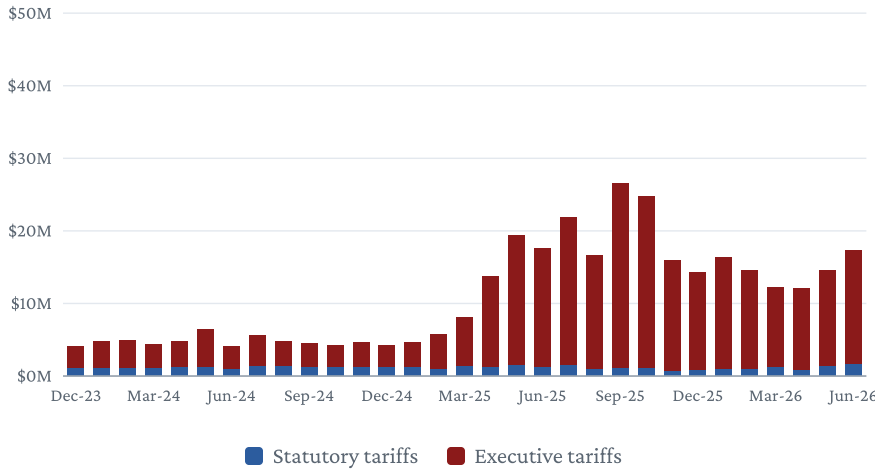

Key South Dakota Imports Facing Executive Tariffs

Food & beverages	\$30M	9.3%	9.1× the 2024 rate of 1.0%
Household goods	\$27M	36.8%	2.2× the 2024 rate of 16.5%
Steel, aluminum & other metals	\$19M	45.7%	37× the 2024 rate of 1.2%
Auto parts	\$18M	23.9%	2× the 2024 rate of 12.0%

Methodology. Figures are estimates of tariffs paid on imports into South Dakota, split between statutory tariffs and executive tariffs imposed by presidential action, of which \$255 million has been imposed since January 2025.
