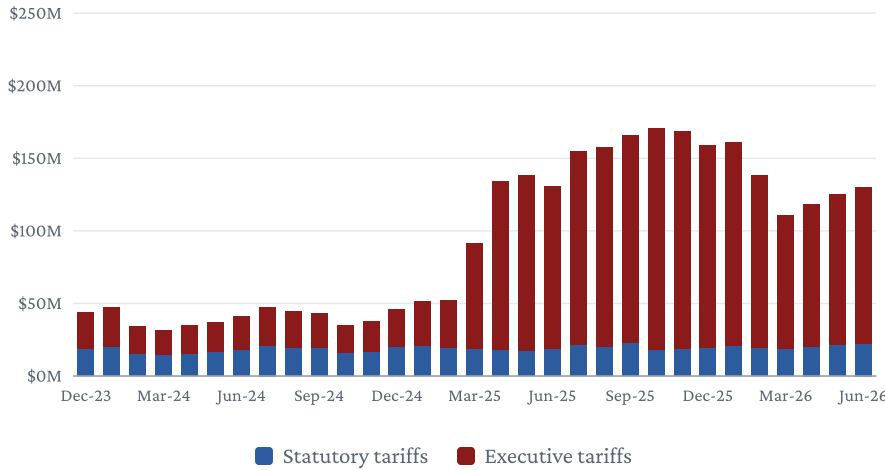

Key Utah Imports Facing Executive Tariffs

Batteries & cables	\$223M	30.3%	2.4× the 2024 rate of 12.8%
Metal products	\$147M	27.5%	3.9× the 2024 rate of 7.0%
Clothes & shoes	\$130M	29.7%	2× the 2024 rate of 14.6%
Electrical equipment	\$108M	17.4%	3.4× the 2024 rate of 5.1%

Methodology. Figures are estimates of tariffs paid on imports into Utah, split between statutory tariffs and executive tariffs imposed by presidential action, of which \$2 billion has been imposed since January 2025.
