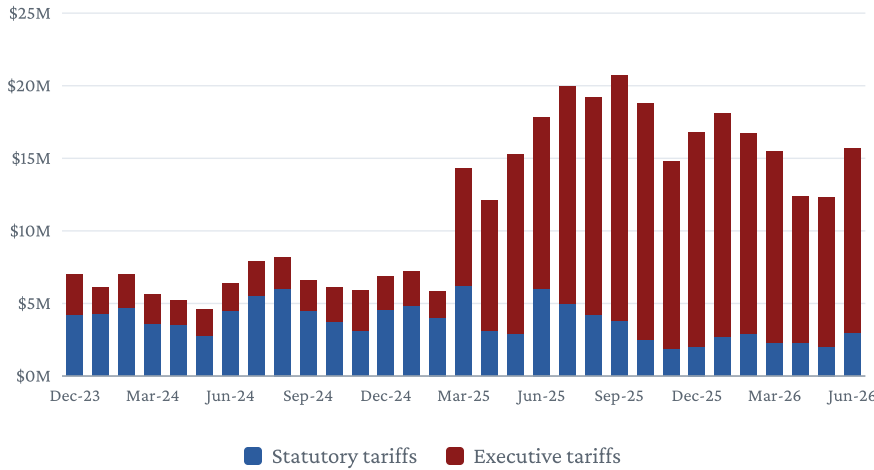

Key Vermont Imports Facing Executive Tariffs

Ag & construction equipment	\$31M	10.0%	37× the 2024 rate of 0.3%
Clothes & shoes	\$23M	23.4%	1.5× the 2024 rate of 15.5%
Metal products	\$16M	14.1%	4.5× the 2024 rate of 3.2%
Toys & games	\$12M	24.0%	4.4× the 2024 rate of 5.4%

Methodology. Figures are estimates of tariffs paid on imports into Vermont, split between statutory tariffs and executive tariffs imposed by presidential action, of which \$212 million has been imposed since January 2025.
