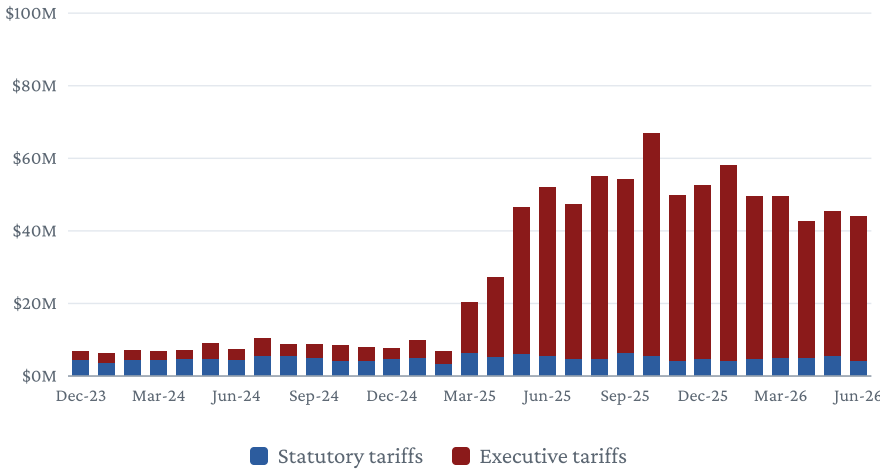

Estimated Tariffs on Imports into West Virginia

Key West Virginia Imports Facing Executive Tariffs

Steel, aluminum & other metals	\$154M	27.6%	19× the 2024 rate of 1.5%
Auto parts	\$96M	18.2%	5.9× the 2024 rate of 3.1%
Electrical equipment	\$92M	21.2%	6.3× the 2024 rate of 3.4%
Aerospace products & parts	\$40M	2.4%	4.6× the 2024 rate of 0.5%

Methodology. Figures are estimates of tariffs paid on imports into West Virginia, split between statutory tariffs and executive tariffs imposed by presidential action, of which \$687 million has been imposed since January 2025.
