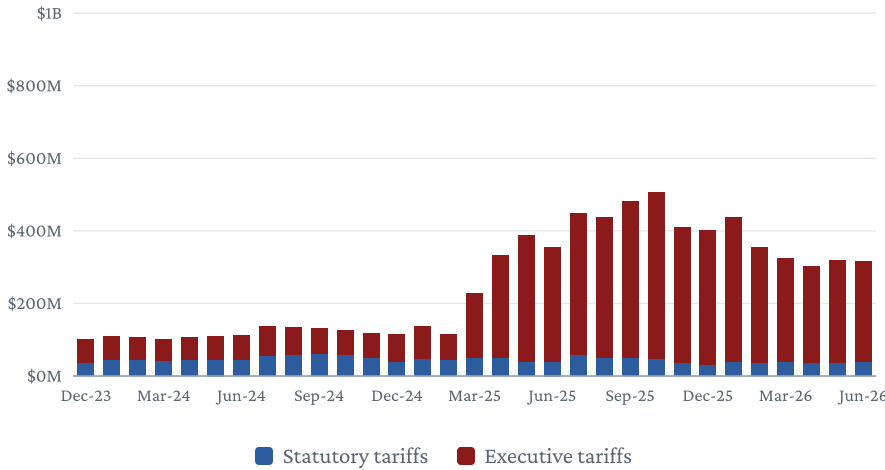

 Household goods	\$305M	18.5%	2.8× the 2024 rate of 6.7%
 Engines & parts	\$288M	22.2%	3.8× the 2024 rate of 5.9%

Methodology. Figures are estimates of tariffs paid on imports into Wisconsin, split between statutory tariffs and executive tariffs imposed by presidential action, of which \$5.5 billion has been imposed since January 2025.
